The Inclsuive Needs Program

THE FAMILY SUCCESS CENTER'S INCLUSIVE NEEDS PROGRAM SUPPORTS THOSE WITH SPECIAL NEEDS, PROVIDING MEDICAL EQUIPMENT, RESOURCES, AND TRIPS TO CAMP ASSCA IN JACKSON'S GAP, ALABAMA - A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED LEADER IN THERAPEUTIC RECREATION FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS WITH PHYSICAL AND INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES.

Insurance rarely covers equipment not deemed medically necessary, despite some of these items serving as proven contributors to enhancing the quality of life of children, teenagers, and adults. Without insurance, families are unable to afford these expensive items, which could range anywhere from hundreds to thousands of dollars. Something as simple as a wheelchair belt or harness could transform a child's ability to sit, while a helmet, vest, or adaptive car seat increases their protection and comfort.

Specialized books and tablets designed for communication open new worlds for children to connect with loved ones, and implements a deeper level of accessibility for them, allowing them to participate and engage more freely. These devices and items assist in breaking barriers and diminishing obstacles, building an environment where these children grow, connect, and flourish. Furthermore, when these children and families are uplifted, it creates a community of acceptance, raising awareness for populations that are underserved and launching a call to action for others to learn and develop a deeper understanding along the pathway of provoking positive change.

Family Success Center's Inclusive Needs Program is a proven and effective initiative, which has already touched numerous lives across the Center's service area. The Inclusive Needs Program's direct positive impact on its community is evident in its established success, demonstrating an investment in the IN Program generates worthwhile and significant results.

402 families were enrolled into the program, while \$3,000 of transportation assistance was distributed. 24 support groups (12 inperson and 12 virtual) were established for caregivers and parents, with six support groups specifically addressing teenagers and young adults with special needs. Through the IN Program, 20 individuals traveled to CAMP ASCCA for either the full camp week, or the newcomer weekend camp experience.

While the primary purpose of the IN Program resides with providing support for local populations with disabilities, an additional component of the program emerges in education.

Representatives of Family Success Center conducted speaking engagements and connected with government officials and fellow non-profit organizations to raise awareness and advocacy for special needs children, teenagers, and adults, to further expand the IN Program's impact.

Through these educational sessions and collaborative meetings with the Etowah County Commission, Gadsden City Council, Rainbow City Council, Glencoe City Council, Etowah County Board of Education, and local mayors, the IN Program extended its outreach efforts and sparked discussion to broaden the conversation about what services agencies can provide demographics with disabilities. Family Success Center partnered with United Abilities. Children's Rehabilitation Services, and the Children's Policy Council to educate, advocate, and acclimate local communities to the importance of this initiative, while coupling action on the Center's part to fulfill the initial mission of service established at the program's

The Inclusive Needs Program contributed directly to the purchase of helmets, standers, vests, adaptive seating and equipment, hearing aids, walkers, and specialized car seats.

Those with special needs are often overlooked, with resources to assist them and their families limited in Etowah County. Apart from Family Success Center's Inclusive Needs Program, no program providing medical and lifeenhancing equipment to special needs individuals exists in Etowah County.

The Inclusive Needs Program is the sole program in operation within this region of Alabama, meaning, it is the sole provider of equipment and resources to these families.
